Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Charlotte came with the Abraham Smoot – George Wallace Company, left Elk Horn River Jun. 18, 1847 and arrived Sep. 25, 26, 29.

-Charlotte traveled to Utah without any family. (Mormon Pioneer Overland Travel, <https://history.lds.org/overlandtravel/companies/276/abraham-o-smoot-george-b-wallace-company-1847>).

-By 1860 Charlotte had remarried to Jeremiah Woodbury. (1860 U.S. Census, Great Salt Lake City, pg. 100; Ancestry, https://www.ancestry.com/genealogy/records/charlotte-frost-train_11503949).

-Both Charlotte and her husband, Jeremiah Woodbury passed away within two days of each other in 1883 in Salt Lake City. (<https://www.findagrave.com/cgi-bin/fg.cgi?page=gr&GRid=32118930>).

-Charlotte and her future husband both made the trek to Utah in the Abraham Smoot – George Wallace Company. However, Jeremiah was married at the time. Charlotte and Jeremiah married in 1852 after Jeremiah's wife died in 1851.
