Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Hannah J. Brown was listed as Family #121 in Utah, Utah Territory.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Came west with the Daniel Spencer/Perrigrine Sessions Company in 1847. 185 individuals and 75 wagons were in the company when it began its journey from the outfitting post on the Elkhorn River about 27 miles west of Winter Quarters, Nebraska.

Any interesting facts or stories that might have been submitted.

The story is told by Rulon Wilson. Isaac H. Brown was sent by Brigham Young to southern Utah and points south on an exploring trip. They were sent to scout for areas where groups of Saints might be sent to colonize the areas. Isaac H. Brown was one of the "Fourth Ten." He was called Ike.

After completing the scouting, Isaac visited the gold fields in California and was carrying gold or gold dust back with him. He was attacked by 3 or 4 men who shot and killed him.

At a later time, one of these robbers lay very ill. Someone visiting him noticed and recognized Isaac's rifle standing in the corner of the room. The sick man was asked, "Where did you get that gun?" The man then admitted, since he was dying anyway, that he and the others had jumped Isaac, shot him, stole his gold, and then dumped his boy in a crevice.

That is why the family never saw him again, or knew where he was buried, or what had really happened to his for sure.
