

## Maryette Robison

Peter Robison was the son of William Henry Robison. Peter Robison married Celina Hayward Chafee 6 October 1839 at Gilbert Mills, Oswego, New York some five and a half years before his niece, Jane, had married John Ackerley at the same place(?). By the summer of 1841 Peter and Celina Robison are found in Montrose, Iowa (across the river from Nauvoo) where their first child, Maryette Robison, is born on 24 August 1841. Five years after that their first son David Peter Robison is born on 17 September 1846 at Winter Quarters. Then eight months later on 23 May 1847 the infant David Peter died. Then their six-year-old daughter, Maryette, died only four months later on 10 September 1847. Both of them, died at Winter Quarters. Probably following the death of her uncle and aunt's only two children Jane Robison Pack gave custody of Elsie Ann Akerley (who was just 16 months younger than Maryette) to her uncle and aunt. On the second anniversary (17 September 1848) of their deceased son's (David Peter) birth the Peter & Celina Robisons have a new daughter they name Celina Cornelia Robison. The Peter Robison family then leaves for the Great Salt Lake Valley the next summer on 10 July 1849 with the Silas Richards Company. In the transcribed company roster they are listed as Peter Robison (32), Celina Hayward Chafee Robison (28), Cornelia Celina Robison (1) and Elva Ann Robison (7—birth listed as ca. 1842). In the 1850 Census for Great Salt Lake, Great Salt Lake County is found the Peter Robinson (Robison) family. Transcribed they are listed as follows: Peter age 34 born in Penn., Selina (Celina) age 30 born in Penn., Elsa Ann (Elsie Ann) age 8 born in Iowa., Selina (Celina) age 2 born in WQ (mis-transcribed as Missouri)., and Charles age 8/12 born in Deseret.
