Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? His family was listed as #27 in District 22, Fremont, Iowa

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Came west with the Crandell Dunn Company in 1852. He was with the McGaw company when it was organized, but very shortly after split off with about 40 others, led by Crandell Dunn. This new company traveled to the Valley independently.
