Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Daniel was listed as Philip Olmstead, family #27, in Fremont, Iowa.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Went west with the Crandell Dunn Company in 1852. Daniel was with the McGaw company when it was organized, but very shortly after split off with about 40 others, led by Crandell Dunn. This new company traveled to the Valley independently.
