Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Ezra Benson Company, 1852 (emailed source, comment 4, p. 896) According to <https://history.lds.org/overlandtravel/companies/315/cyrus-h-wheelock-company-1853> George traveled with the Cyrus Wheelock Company which left Keokuk, Iowa on June 1, 1853 and arrived Oct. 6, 1853. His first wife Dorcus and their three children came with the Allen Weeks Company which left July 13, 1852 from Kanessville, Iowa and arrived Oct. 12, 1852.
