Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Mary living with grandparents in Weber County, house #13. Daniel and daughter Ruth in Davis County, house #114.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Daniel and Ruth Clarissa went with the Aaron Johnson Co. left Kanesville, Iowa on June 8, 1850 and arrived Sep. 12.

Any interesting facts or stories that might have been submitted.

-Sally was Daniel's second wife. Daniel married Sally Dec. 23, 1845 in Nauvoo. His first wife was Clarissa Amelia Foster and they were married Sep. 26, 1829 in Benson Vermont. Daniel later married Mary Legresley (11/9/1855) and Cordelia Hotchkiss (5/2/1856). (Daniel Carter File, emailed file, 5168).

-Daniel became a High Priest Oct. 24, 1841. (High Priest Record, Qrm organized at Nauvoo, 1840, LDS Archives).

-Sally's husband, Daniel, was 23 years older than she was. (Daniel Carter, p.760, emailed). Sally was 17 when she married Daniel.

-With his first wife Daniel had the following children: Harriet Amelia, Orin, Ruth Clarissa, Jabez. (Daniel Carter, p.760, emailed).

-Daniel and Sally had Mary who was born Dec. 3 1846 just two months before Sally's death. (Daniel Carter, p.760, emailed).

-Daniel was baptized Dec. of 1833. (Daniel Carter, p.762, emailed).

-After Sally's death their daughter Mary was raised by Sally's family the Perry's. Daniel had no more children after Mary, despite taking two more wives. (Mark Redd, Sons of Utah Pioneers: Conquerors of the West, "Daniel Carter")

-Mary traveled to Utah with her Perry grandparents sometime before 1851. (Mary Eliza Carter, <https://history.lds.org/overlandtravel/pioneers/51647/mary-eliza-carter>)

-Daniel and his family lived with Hyrum Smith and his family in Kirtland, OH for a while until they could purchase property.

-Daniel died in Bountiful, UT on April 10, 1887.
