-Frederick Sr. and Nancy were married March 25, 1841 in Clay, Indiana. They had David Benton Ott on March 10, 1842 in Clay, Indiana.

-Frederick Sr. died in Nauvoo, Illinois in January of 1845 from a fit of apoplexy. (Lyndon W. Cook, Nauvoo Deaths and Marriages: 1839-1845, Orem, UT: Grandin Book Company, 1994, 58, Harold B. Lee Library, Brigham Young University, Provo, UT 84602, BX 8677.73 .C772n 1994.) Other sources say that Frederick Sr. was killed by a mob in Nauvoo. -Frederick Sr. was a Campbell Minister who joined the church and served a mission. (Letter from Jill Neilson, 3601 S. 2200 W. West Valley City, UT 84119 (May 24, 2004).) He was born in Rockcastle Kentucky, baptized in 1842, and served a mission to Indiana. (70's Record)

-Nancy remarried to Clayborne Elder on Feb. 9, 1853. However, she did not have any more children. (The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Iowa Branch Index, 1839-1859 (1991).) Nancy was Claybourne's 4th wife.
