From the original Sexton Records:

Not listed 1851 “My husband and I visited the City of the Dead. There at rest we found old Brother Bosley and his wife. This was a great surprise to my husband, as the winter before the Saints left Nauvoo, he and his father had worked for Mr. Bosley.” (Card, Rebecca. *Heart Throbs of the West*, vol. 12. Salt Lake City: Daughters of the Utah Pioneers)

Death Date: May 12, 1849

Cause of Death: Unknown

Burial Place: Probably next to her husband

Father's Name: Daniel Kelly

Mother's Maiden Name: Elizabeth Baxter

Spouse's Name: Edmund Bosley

Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Both were deceased before 1850
