Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Great Salt Lake County, UT, house #61. Charles age 46, Achsah age 36, Jane age 14 (daughter from her former marriage to Abraham Sargent), Mary age 3, Martha age 1.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Achsah, Charles, Mary, and Martha traveled with an unknown company in the summer/fall of 1850.

Any interesting facts or stories that might have been submitted.

-Charles, the father, was re-baptized May 11, 1851 in Utah. He was born in Canada in 1804. (<https://history.lds.org/overlandtravel/pioneers/11300660760037289842/charles-y-packett;1850census>)

-Achsah was born in Virginia in 1814. (1850 Census). She was married to Abraham Sargent prior to her marriage to Charles.

-In 1860 they were in Spanish Fork, UT. Charles was working as a carpenter. Their children Mary age 12, Martha Ann age 10, Emeline age 7, Emily age 7, (Julia) Achsah age 5, Joseph age 3 were living with them.

-By 1870 the family was farming in Spanish Fork Utah. Charles age 64, Axey (Achsah) age 54, Emeline age 17, Julia (Achsah) age 16, Joseph age 13, and Nancy age 62 (from France, perhaps a second wife) were living in the house together.
