Which Winter Quarters Ward or Iowa Branch was the family? Alonzo was in the 1st ward. Her parents were in the 14th ward

Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Alonzo is remarried to a Susan and living in Weber county, Utah, house 11, page 148 with their two small children. Her parents are living in Great Salt Lake County, Utah, house 162, page 35.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Her parents and siblings left with the Heber C. Kimball Company from Winter Quarters June 7, 1848 and arrived Sep. 24, 1848. Her husband's company is unknown.

Any interesting facts or stories that might have been submitted.

-She was only married to Alonzo 2 years and 9 months before she died.

-Hannah was seventh of eleven children, several of whom died before they reached Utah.

-Her marriage to Alonzo was performed by Harrison Burgess, Hannah's brother, in Nauvoo.

- William, her father, was a blacksmith in 1850, but in 1860 and 1870 he was a farmer. (1850 U.S. Census, house 162, p. 35), (1860 U.S. Census, 16th Ward Salt Lake City, p.158), (U.S. Census 1870, Washington County, Utah, p.3).
