Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Ephraim (brother) was married to Ann and living in Utah County, UT, house #235. His younger brother, Elias age 20 was living with the family too.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Ephraim went with the Mormon battalion, Elias came with the Abraham O. Smoot – George B. Wallace Co. which left from the Elkhorn River June 18, 1847 and arrived Sep. 25-29.
