William Gibson Sterrett joined The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints on 6 October 1850 and moved to Nauvoo, Hancock, Illinois. He was ordained a seventy and received his endowment on 10 January 1846 in the Nauvoo Temple. He was listed among the Nauvoo List of Members, and also on the Continuing Church Record at Nauvoo. He moved to Winter Quarters, Nebraska, and later to Utah in 1850. William was baptized a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in 1870 by D. H. Smith. He was a cabinetmaker.
