Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Isaac Bullock Company, left Kanesville (present Counsel Bluffs), Iowa in 1852 and arrived between Sep. 21 and Oct. 3 1852.

-His brother, John Cummings, who was 5 years older than him also died at Winter's Quarters and was buried in Cutlers Park grave #24. (see John Cummings sheet for more facts/stories)

-His father, George was a private in Company E of the Mormon Battalion. (Members of the Mormon Battalion, Susan W. Easton, Roster of Mormon Battalion.)

-Jane, his mother, was the first baptized on July 20, 1841 in St. Joseph, Vanderburgh, Indiana. His father was baptized the following year.
